General Education / Degree Requirements

(These requirements apply only to students using the Fall 2010 Bulletin or later for the B.F.A or B.M. degree.)

All Bachelor of Fine Arts and Bachelor of Music degree students must satisfy general education requirements set by the College of Letters & Science and satisfy all degree requirements specific to these degree programs:

1. Complete a minimum of 42 credits of general education
2. Achieve the specified, minimum *cumulative* grade point average as required by the declared major
3. Meet any specified grade requirements, minimum grade point average requirements *in course work* for the declared major and/or minor, and satisfy all requirements for progression in the major
4. Complete a minimum of 120 degree credits of which 35 must be upper level (300 and 400 level course work) with a minimum grade point average of 2.0 across all attempted credits

Notes: 1) If you have earned an associate or baccalaureate degree at a UW College or University, see your UARC advisor regarding requirements that have already been met. 2) An (H) indicates a University Honors Program approved course.
