2. We anticipate students being able to declare the new major sometime in mid-October 2012 (TitanWeb requires programming for any new major and that does not happen overnight).
3. The new major is NOT identical to the draft version that was posted for quite some time on the Biology Dept website. **THROW AWAY THE DRAFT VERSION!**
4. This version (Plan B) is for students who declare the new major in Fall 2012 or Spring 2013 but will be taking classes at least through December 2013... long enough to enjoy the benefits of the improved program coming in Fall 2013. Because you started the Rad Sci major before University Studies “kicked in”, you will continue your degree under General Education.
5. You can attend ANY accredited School of Radiology to complete your UW Oshkosh degree. Just make sure it is accredited by the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists (<https://www.arrt.org/Education/Educational-Programs>).
6. Some Rad Schools require *prior CNA certification*. If you haven’t gotten this yet, check out Fox Valley Tech’s 120-hour program at <http://www.fvtc.edu/public/academics/degree.aspx?plan=30-543-1>.
7. If you have *already completed* Radiology School and just want to come back to UW Oshkosh to complete course credits, please stay tuned; we are working on how that will be accomplished.
8. If you are *ready to go* to Radiology School and want to retain your status as a UW Oshkosh student in order to continue qualifying for financial aid, please stay tuned; we are working on how that will be accomplished.
9. We are planning an open house for the new major in early-to-mid October 2012, including a presentation by the director of a regional School of Radiology. Watch for advertisements on the Halsey bulletin boards.
