Except for where noted (), a 2.5 combined grade point average, 60 credits and all course prerequisites are required for enrollment in the (300-400) Business courses.*

There is a limit of 6 credits in the (300-400) Business courses per semester and up to a maximum of 21 credits total without being admitted to the College of Business.

A 2.0 minimum grade point average is required in all minor courses.
