Consider the **Autism Spectrum Disorders (ASD) Certificate Program** to expand your preparation for today's diverse classrooms!

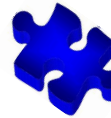
**This ASD program is designed for:**

## UW Oshkosh ASD Certificate Program

### Core Program Components

Include:

- Understanding characteristics and causes of autism
- Meeting communication and sensory needs
- Applying behavioral interventions across settings
- Creating educational programs for students with ASD

Participants with experience working with individuals with ASD can apply to have the practicum requirement waived.



To complete the certificate, participants who are enrolled in the UW Oshkosh Special Education program may only need **2** additional courses!
