Criteria for Waiver of Special Education 370

-  Documented evidence of successful completion of one year's experience as a teacher aide, or one-half year's experiences as a teacher, or 420 hours as a substitute teacher for students with a variety of disabilities (e.g., cognitive disabilities, emotional disabilities, or learning disabilities). This must include the dates and assignments within the past 7 years.
-  A minimum of two letters from administrators or supervisors testifying to the dates of past experiences, professional behavior (e.g., empathy, initiative, and punctuality), and appropriate interpersonal relationships.
-  An interview with the Practicum Waiver Committee may be required if there is need for further information or clarification regarding the documented evidence provided.

Criteria for Waiver of Special Education 401/601

- Documented evidence of completion of one semester teaching in a school full-time.
- A letter from the school administrator attesting to the dates of your employment and addressing your instructional practices, behavior management, and professionalism.

NOTE: If you are applying for a waiver for the fall, your waiver request and documentation must be filed with the Practicum Committee by May 1st of the preceding semester. Similarly, those applying for a waiver for the spring semester must submit their request and documentation by December 1st of the preceding semester.
