*Applications are due back in the Department Office on **Friday, December 16th, 2011.***

If you plan on graduating in Spring or Summer 2012, you probably want to register for this exam.



### Test Date & Time

Saturday, April 21, 2012  
9:00 AM

### Cost

\$295 payable by MONEY ORDER only to NBCC

In most cases registration for the exam starts no later than 8:30 AM on the exam date. The Exam Administrator should begin reading instructions at 9:00 AM.

The NCE is comprised of 200 multiple choice questions and is scheduled for a 4-hour period. Most examinees complete the exam in 2 1/2—3 hours.

Admission letters, specifying the exam location and directions, will be mailed directly to the applicants 7-10 days prior to the exam date.
