

Meeting of Humanities Division

March 15, 2007: 1:00, N/E 107

I. Minutes of January 18, 2007 were unanimously approved.

II. Program and course actions:

- English: Course Deletion-English 725, Teaching of Writing: Neal made a motion to approve it. Behm seconded it. The motion was approved unanimously.
- Women's Studies: Request to Plan a Major: Behm made a motion to approve it. Rindo seconded it. The motion was approved unanimously.

III. Permanent property requests

- Women's Studies' request and African American Studies requests were withdrawn. They will go through the Social Science Division.
- Communication: Radio-TV-Film's request of \$85,897.79 was the only request for the category over \$20,000.
- Each Humanities Division member cast a vote to determine the ranking of the requests made by Foreign Languages and Literatures (\$3,348.84), Communication & Radio-TV-Film (\$6,481), English (\$5,923.02) and Religious Studies and Anthropology (\$5,360.44). As a result, the request by Communication & Radio-TV-Film received the highest ranking. The rest of the requests received almost the equal number of votes and it was difficult to determine the order.
