1. Meeting was called to order by Grzyb at 1:38PM.
2. Minutes of the meeting #5 (February 1, 2007) were approved unanimously (Simmons/Bannan).
3. Simmons presented new course proposals for POL SCI 365: Politics of Emergency Management and PUB ADMIN 366: Emergency Planning and Administration and a proposal for changes in major and minor in Political Science for discussion and approval. These courses will be required for Fire and Emergency Management majors, and they will be added to the Public Administration emphasis in the Political Science major. Approved unanimously (Behm/Barricelli).
4. Koch presented course revision proposals for PSYCH 774: Psychological Research (number of credits and grading basis) and PSYCH 795: Psychology Thesis (number of credits, course description, and prerequisites) and a proposal for revision of Master's degree requirement in Psychology for discussion and approval. The Master's degree requirement proposal calls for 12 credits of content courses (instead of 9), a decrease in the number of credits for PSYCH 774 by one, and an increase in the number of credits required by two to the total of 33 credits. Approved unanimously (Behm/Simmons).
5. Cross reminded chairs to send departmental meeting minutes to the Dean's Office electronically and to send one copy to lsoffice@uwosh.edu.
