**General Health of UW Oshkosh Students**

UW Oshkosh 2007: 52.1% of students surveyed (53.7% male and 51.3% female) described their health as very good or excellent.  
 UW Oshkosh 2006: 50.9% of students surveyed (53.4 male and 50.3% female) described their health as very good or excellent.  
 UW Oshkosh 2003: 50.9% of students surveyed (58.1% male and 49.2% female) described their health as very good or excellent.  
 UW Oshkosh 2000: 49.4% of students surveyed (45.5% male and 51.3% female) described their health as very good or excellent.  
 National 2006: 61.2% of students surveyed (64.7% male and 59.4% female) described their health as very good or excellent.
