**The University of Wisconsin-Oshkosh, Department of Journalism**, seeks a tenure-track assistant professor to teach undergraduate courses in writing/editing and possibly media studies beginning Sept. 1, 2008. A master's degree in Journalism/Communication and significant professional experience OR a Ph.D. in Journalism/Communication and some professional experience is a minimum requirement. A Ph.D. in Journalism/Communication and significant professional experience preferred. ABD's completed by Sept. 2008 will be considered.

Candidates must be able to teach Writing for the Media, Editing, Reporting, Feature Writing, and Introduction to Journalism and Mass Communication. Desire to teach courses in one or more emphases in media studies, visual journalism, advertising, and public relations is preferred, but not required. Teaching load is 3 courses per semester with the approval of curriculum modification. Interest in advising a student organization and ability to integrate new media technologies in classes are preferable. Advising students and conducting scholarly research and/or professional growth are expected.
