

# FLORENCE MINING NEWS

The Florence Mining News is offering a 12-week student internship beginning in mid-January. This is a paid internship in which students will receive rigorous training in community journalism and weekly newspaper production.

Students will function primarily as reporters, but they also will receive training in layout and design, editing and photography. Students who demonstrate superior skills and dependability will have the opportunity to serve as the paper's managing editor for up to four weeks.

Only students who have taken basic editing, basic news writing, reporting and advanced reporting will be considered. In lieu of advanced reporting, the Florence Mining News would consider a student who has done reporting or editing for the university newspaper or at another reputable newspaper or periodical. Students will work a 35-hour week.

The internship begins January 21, 2010.
