These materials will include: editorial page layout, brochures, flyers, circulation cards, ads, logo design, and more.

Job Description Management and implementation of photo and logo libraries and handling requests for photos, logos and previously designed materials from our archives; Scanning and filing artwork as needed; Coordinating aspects of photo shoots including making calls, setting appointments, buying props and assisting the Art Director on shoots when needed. Other duties may be assigned.

Job Qualifications

Applicants must be juniors, seniors or graduate students studying Graphic Design and having an interest in home, garden and personal style is helpful. We ask interns to commit to a minimum of 10 hours each week. The internship offers an honest, in-depth look at how a magazine operates, and a talented student will end up with some published and printed samples for a portfolio.

Must be Mac savvy with proficiency in Quark Xpress, and the Adobe Creative Suite (InDesign, Illustrator, Photoshop) as well as Microsoft Office software. Knowledge of style sheets is a must; experience with publication design a plus. Must be able to work in a fast-paced environment with sometimes minimal supervision. You will report directly to and work with the Art Director to ensure consistent branding and content.
