**Homework:** Homework will be assigned each class and discussed some. Students are expected to come to class with the assignment completed and the next section read. These problems will not be collected for grading but used for discussion.

**Quizzes:** Every week when there is no exam, there will be a quiz. Quizzes must be taken at the time they are scheduled in class.
