****The math department reserves the right to set a minimum winning score.**

TO BE ELIGIBLE TO TAKE THE EXAM:

- 1) You must have completed or be currently enrolled in 67-172, Calculus II (or the equivalent in the case of a transfer student)
- AND
- 2) You cannot have completed nor be currently enrolled in any mathematics course numbered above 301.

The exam will test concepts covered in the first two semesters of calculus, including limits, differentiation, and integration. A graphics programmable calculator, provided it cannot perform symbolic manipulations, may be used on the exam.

Sign up to take the exam in the Mathematics Department Office, Swart 115, by 4:00 pm on Friday, April 10th. The exam will be given on Tuesday, April 14th at 5:00 pm in Swart 13.
