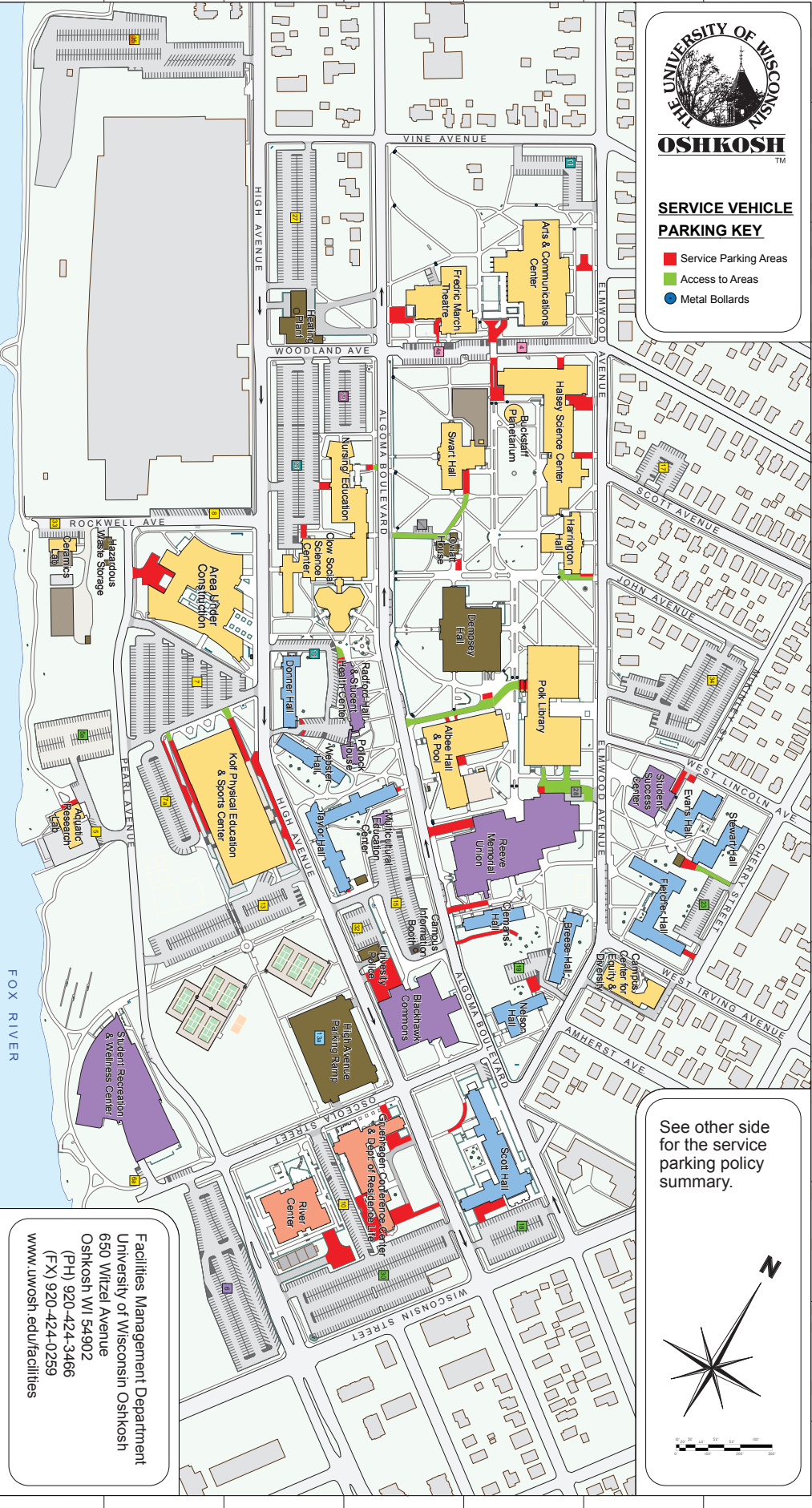

Service Vehicle Policy Summary



Off Road Operation

Off Road Operation of vehicles is **prohibited at all times**, with the following exceptions:

- Grounds Vehicles involved in grounds maintenance or snow removal
- Service vehicles when off-road operation/parking is essential to the performance of maintenance or construction functions
- Service vehicles when involved in an emergency (i.e. flooding, power failure, etc...)
- Emergency vehicles
- Golf cart style off-road vehicles
- When warranted in association with events. Such determination will be made by University Police and Parking Services based upon conditions existing at the time of the event

Use of Service Stalls

In order to provide access to campus facilities, service areas have been designated at appropriate locations throughout the academic campus. Service, maintenance, vendor and delivery vehicles shall routinely park in designated service areas. Please see the attached campus map for exact locations of these stalls and areas.

The use of service parking stalls and areas is restricted to:

- Emergency vehicles
- University owned service vehicles
- Vehicles displaying a valid service vehicle permit
- Vehicles displaying a valid loading/delivery permit
- Vehicles displaying a valid Staff permit for no longer than 30 minutes, for the purpose of loading and unloading, between the hours of 7:00 ^{AM} and 5:00 ^{PM} Monday through Friday, all day on Saturdays, Sundays and state holidays.

Vendors

Vendors requiring access to campus facilities must register with the Parking Office and have and display a valid loading/delivery permit or service permit. Vendors who send different/multiple vehicles to campus should have a permit for each vehicle. Exceptions **may** be granted for vendors with vehicles that clearly identify the name of the company on the vehicle.

Construction Activities

The Director of Facilities Management will notify Parking Services of impending construction activities and will identify off-road and landscaped areas designated for construction staging and vehicle parking. The Director of Facilities Management will also indicate the quantity and type of vehicles that will be granted special parking privileges. It will be the contractor(s) responsibility to obtain and display required service permits from the Parking Office. If the Project is relatively small, the contractor(s) may be directed to obtain a temporary service parking permit and will be required to park in the designated service areas. The contractor(s) will be responsible for obtaining required temporary service vehicle permits from the Parking Office. **Contractor(s) will not be granted special parking privileges for personal vehicles on campus grounds.**
