## **Study Abroad Scholarship Application**

### **About the Scholarship**

The James Grunloh Economics Study Abroad Scholarship provides \$200 of financial support for one qualified UW Oshkosh economics major or minor to participate in an approved economics study abroad program. These programs include the Study Abroad to Peru, the Economics in Scotland program, or the Germany Economics of European Integration program.

### **Responsibilities of Scholarship Recipients**

- The recipient must be able to attend the annual departmental banquet (date to be announced)
- The recipient is responsible for carrying out follow-up projects and promotions for study abroad, including attending the study abroad fairs.

### **Eligibility Requirements**

To be eligible a student must

- Be an enrolled undergraduate at the University of Wisconsin Oshkosh
- Have declared a major or minor in Economics
- Be in good academic standing
- Have a completed and accepted application for an economics study abroad program

### **Application Process**

To apply, please include the following items. The deadline for applications is the second Wednesday of March. Notification will be made by the end of March.

1. Verification from the Office of International Education of your completed application for an economics study abroad program.
2. A resume.
3. A copy of your star report or transcript.
4. A one-page statement on why you want to participate in a study abroad program, and what you hope to get out of the experience.
