## Concert Report Questions:

1. List five or more things you noticed, and you think children would notice, about the procedural aspects of the concert/recital?
2. List ten or more visual aspects of the concert/recital, which you think children would notice?
3. Using appropriate music terminology in paragraph form, describe two pieces, including the last piece of music performed. Use the elements of music as a guide. Correct sentence structure, punctuation, grammar, and spelling are expected.
4. List and describe seven activities you might use to prepare children for this concert, or to engage them in another live experience with this type of music?
5. Attach a copy of the concert program.

## Reminders:

Correct sentence structure, punctuation, grammar, and spelling are expected.  
Use consistent verb tenses.  
Most titles of songs should be in quotes.  
Commas and periods go inside quotes.  
Check for run-on sentences.
