Instructions: Drawing upon any resources available to you including reserve items and those used in class, develop a broad monthly curriculum for one grade level, K-5. Choose 2 National standards on which your curriculum will focus. Follow the guidelines below and the model provided. This project must be typed.

1. Develop monthly and weekly objectives for the months of September, October, November, January, February, March, and April.
 - Assume there are four weeks in each month and you meet your class once each week
 - Identify a single content standard and achievement standard which will be the focus for each month (choose a different achievement standard for each month)
 - Following the sample format, include for each month:
 - Content Standard
 - Achievement Standard
 - Monthly Objectives
 - Prerequisite Skills
 - Weekly Objectives (4)
 - Monthly Assessment Strategy
 - Description of student responses
 - Basic Level
 - Proficient Level
 - Advanced Level
2. Choose any four weeks (four lessons) of the 28 you have outlined and create a complete lesson plan (including task analysis) for them. Include copies of songs and materials needed.
3. Create a customized grade report card (to be sent to parents) with specific criteria related to your curriculum.
