Global Educator Graduate Certificate Program

Graduate certificates offered by the University of Wisconsin Oshkosh are designed to provide students with specialized knowledge and skills to foster personal and professional development. Specifically the Global Educator Graduate Certificate is 16-18 graduate credits (post bachelor's study) that provide an overview, theory, philosophy, and historical and current perspectives on issues surrounding education, program development, and global citizenship. The Global Educator Certificate program is designed to be a cohort of students with a shared learning experience that will prepare them to teach their own students and colleagues to be educated global citizens.

Admission Criteria:

- √ Bachelor's Degree
- √ A minimum 2.75 undergraduate grade point average.
- √ Admission will be considered on an individual basis for those who don't meet specific criteria.

Please note that students will need to travel in a study abroad experience sometime during participation in the certificate program. This requirement will be explained in more detail during the introductory certificate courses.

Submit the following materials to the **Graduate Studies Office, 800 Algoma Blvd., Dempsey Hall 337, Oshkosh WI 54901** for admission to the certificate program:

1. A completed application form and a \$45.00 application fee (check or money order). Certificate applicants already admitted to and a fee paid for the Educational Leadership graduate program or another UW Oshkosh graduate program do not pay this fee. This fee is non-refundable.
2. A 1-2 page essay describing your background for and interest in the Global Educator Certificate program. Also please include a statement of your goals.
3. Official undergraduate transcript showing completion of a bachelor's degree from an accredited institution.

Follow the application checklist for assistance with completing and submitting your certificate application. **Apply now.
