*Graduate Certificate in  
Natural Alternative Complementary Health Care*

Graduate certificates offered by the University of Wisconsin Oshkosh are designed to provide students with specialized knowledge and skills to foster personal and professional development. Specifically the graduate certificate in Natural Alternative Complementary (NAC) Health Care is post-bachelor's study that provides an overview, theory, philosophy, and historical perspective of NAC Health Care.

Admission Criteria:

- √ Bachelor's in Nursing
- √ A minimum 3.00 grade point average.
- √ Admission will be considered on an individual basis for those who don't meet specific criteria.

Submit the following materials to the Graduate Studies office for admission to the certificate program:

1. A completed application form and \$45 application fee.
2. A brief application essay stating why you are seeking admission to the certificate program.
3. Official undergraduate transcript showing completion of a bachelor's degree from an accredited institution.

Follow the application checklist for assistance with completing and submitting your certificate application. **Application deadline for summer 2007 is June 1, 2007 for registration to NURSING 770 - Introduction to Natural Alternative Complementary (NAC) Health Care - 1 credit. Certificate questions will be answered at the first meeting of this introductory class. Persons wishing to pursue the certificate will be able to apply following completion of the class if not done prior.** Note that the introductory course is open to all eligible students even if not pursuing the certificate. The introductory course, however, is required for continuing in the certificate program.

Once admitted, students must complete all academic work applying toward the certificate within four years of the first course taken toward the certificate.
