ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS:

The Department of Physics and Astronomy at UW-Oshkosh seek applicants for a tenure-track position in Electrical Engineering Technology

This position includes the following responsibilities:

- Play a significant role in course and curriculum development in the start-up phase of a new electrical engineering technology program
- Teach lower- and upper-level courses in electrical engineering technology
- Develop a strong research program involving collaboration with students and faculty.
- Advise students.
- Perform scholarly activities consistent with rank.
- Perform institutional service and contribute to the ongoing programmatic development within the department of Department of Physics and Astronomy (currently housing the new Engineering Technology majors at UW Oshkosh)

In addition, this faculty member will be expected to demonstrate a potential for excellence in teaching and scholarship, display commitment to undergraduate education, and possess communication and interpersonal skills sufficient to work effectively with a diverse array of students and colleagues.

QUALIFICATIONS:

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- Earned doctorate in Electrical Engineering or closely related field from an accredited institution. The degree must be completed no later than May 24, 2015. Will consider ABD candidates who can demonstrate the ability to meet the requirements above.

STARTING DATE: August 25, 2014

CONDITIONS OF APPOINTMENT:

Position is an academic year (9-month) tenure-track appointment. Applicants must be considered for tenure and promotion in six years, although tenure decisions may be at any time. Promotion from Assistant to Associate Professor is simultaneous with tenure. Excellence in teaching, sustained scholarly activity and institutional service required for retention and promotion. Official transcripts of the highest degree achieved will be required of finalist(s). A criminal conviction investigation will be conducted on the finalist(s). In compliance with the Wisconsin Fair Employment Act, the university does not discriminate on the basis of arrest or conviction record.

SALARY:
