CARE and MenCARE (Campus Awareness for Relationship Education) is a peer education group focused on raising awareness and preventing dating violence, sexual assault, stalking and harassment on campus.

Each semester we offer internships and independent studies for students to gain excellent experience in marketing an organization, developing a program and implementing it, working on a team, and learning more about social and emotional issues related to dating and sexual violence. Students working with CARE and MenCARE build a great resume and can receive college credit in the process.

CARE or MenCARE interns attend the weekly volunteer meetings and biweekly intern meetings to work on projects and programs to address increasing awareness and prevention of sexual assault, dating violence, stalking and harassment on campus. Interns read required books and complete a paper and/or project proposal at the end of the semester.
