World AIDS Day



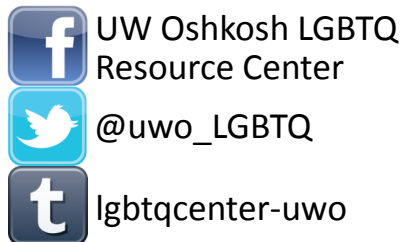
Held annually near December 1st, it is an opportunity for people worldwide to unite in the fight against HIV, show their support for people living with HIV and to commemorate people who have died.

Support & Services

LGBTQ Support Group



Run by the Counseling Center & Professional Counseling Department. LGBTQ+ students meet for an hour weekly to discuss questions of coming out and of life on campus.

Queer Peer Mentoring Program



The mission of QPMP is to help queer and questioning students at UW Oshkosh succeed during their time at the university, reach their full potential as individuals, and connect with other queer UW Oshkosh students.

Rainbow Alliance for H.O.P.E.



H.O.P.E. (Helping Others Perceive Equality) is a student organization that meets Monday evenings in Reeve Union and provides support, education, advocacy, and a social network for LGBTQ+ and Ally students

S.A.F.E. Training



A 2 ½ hour educational ally training offered to students, faculty, and staff to introduce participants to terminology, changing cultural messages, and the coming out process, and to build ally skills.
