- 1) Items can be placed on hold or recalled by another patron, these statuses will block renewal.
- 2) Does not include Educational Media Collection (EMC) videos, video guides, DVDs or software.
- 3) Some UB items such as DVDs and select books check out for 14 days and are not renewable.
- 4) Items such as laptops are available to UW Oshkosh students only.

4. Fox Valley Library Council (FVLC) patrons may check out up to 5 items by obtaining a courtesy card from the FVLC member library in their area. The card can be used once.

5. All items may be returned to the Library Material Returns. Outside returns are located to the right of the Main entrance and in the courtyard facing Elmwood Avenue.

6. Recalls: All materials are subject to recall. A patron's borrowing privileges will be suspended until past due recalled materials are returned.

7. Overdue items: Most materials have a 28-day grace period.

- **At 4 days prior** to due date a courtesy reminder is emailed. You should **renew or return items now**. Notices are sent as a courtesy. Failure to receive notices does not change responsibility for fees incurred. Due dates are stamped on the card in the back of each item and/or can be viewed in "**Your Record**" online from the Polk Library home page. If the item cannot be located, please contact the library at (920) 424-7316.
- **At 7 days overdue** an overdue notice is sent.
- **At 14 days overdue** another overdue notice is sent.
- **At 30 days overdue** a lost item replacement bill is sent. The item replacement fee is **\$50 per item**. Your Library record is now blocked. This means you cannot check out items from Polk Library, Universal Borrowing (UB) or Interlibrary Loan (ILL).
- **At 42 days overdue** your University registration is now blocked. This means you cannot add/drop classes or receive transcripts.
- **At 60 days overdue** a 'past due' bill is sent.
- **At 70 days overdue** a UW Oshkosh invoice is sent. Must be paid in full at Dempsey Cashier's office, 2nd floor. Bring paid-in-full receipt to the Library Circulation Desk to get your library record unblocked.
 - UW Oshkosh students: Borrowing privileges are suspended when fees exceed \$10.
 - Polk Reserve, Halsey Reserve: Late fees are \$0.60 to \$3.00 per hour.
 - Items borrowed from other UB libraries are subject to that institution's policies.

Patron Privileges and Responsibilities

1. UW System students, faculty and staff must present a current, valid university ID to check out library materials.
2. UW Oshkosh patrons may renew materials on-line using the "Your Record" link found on the library home page (<http://www.uwosh.edu/library>). If there is a hold on an item for another patron, the item cannot be renewed.
3. Non-UW System patrons can apply for a NEW ERA guest card to check out a maximum of 20 books at one time if they meet the following criteria:
 - *Are at least 18 years old.
(If under 18 years old, see #4)
 - *Live in Wisconsin.
 - *Present photo identification with current address (i.e. current WI ID cards, driver's licenses or other photo ID.)
