#### **UW Oshkosh Minimum Degree Requirements:**

- ❖ A minimum of 120 credits is required for the conferral of a UW-Oshkosh bachelor's degree
- ❖ No more than 72 credits from *2-year* institutions (WTCS campuses / UW Colleges / Community Colleges / Non-WI Technical Colleges) may be applied to the 120 credit minimum
- ❖ At least 30 of the 120 semester credits for the degree must be earned in UW-Oshkosh courses
- ❖ At least 15 of the final 30 semester credits for the degree must be earned in UW-Oshkosh courses
- ❖ At least 35 credits of upper-level (300/400 level) course work must be successfully completed
- ❖ A minimum cumulative grade point average of *2.0 or higher* is required for conferral of a degree
