What is Darmasiswa Program?

Darmasiswa Scholarship Program is an initiative to build partnerships and for the purpose of increasing mutual understanding through study and international education experience. The program was launched in 1974, initially only for ASEAN countries. Due to immediate success, since then the program has been offered to young generation of all friends of Indonesia around the world.

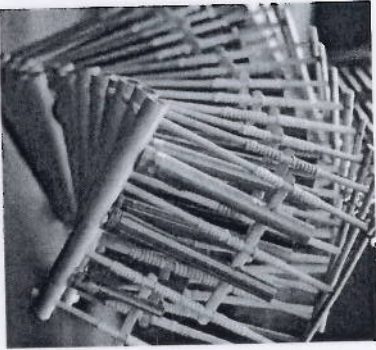
Every academic year, Darmasiswa Program will grant scholarships to American youths and those from other countries wishing to undertake non-degree studies in one of the following fields: Indonesian language (Bahasa Indonesia), dance, music, and arts and crafts in selected Indonesia universities/colleges and teacher training centers.

The scholarship recipients will have opportunities to broaden their experience by living in a cross-cultural environment. They will be eligible for free tuition and other instructional fees, modest living allowance to cover accommodation and other living expenses. They, however, will not be allowed to take employment opportunities, undertake side-research, or involve in political activities.



THE INDONESIAN MINISTRY OF NATIONAL EDUCATION IS offering the following categories of Darmasiswa Scholarship Programs:

- Darmasiswa Regular Program is a one-year scholarship program offered to foreign students from countries which have diplomatic relations with Indonesia to study Indonesian language, traditional music, traditional dance, and Indonesian craft in participating Indonesian Higher Education Institutions
- Darmasiswa Short Course Program is a six-month scholarship program offered to foreign students from countries which have diplomatic relations with Indonesia to study Bahasa Indonesia in participating Indonesian Higher Education Institutions



Who can apply?

Interested applicants must:

- be non-Indonesian citizen
- be under 35 years of age
- have completed Secondary Education or its equivalent
- have a basic knowledge of the proposed field of study
- be in good health as proved by Medical Examination Record
- be able to communicate in English

How and When does it proceed?

The following tables indicate typical estimated timeline. The schedule may vary and be subject to change.

What documents shall be submitted?

- Application Form
- Copy of academic records
- Statement from registered doctor stating that the applicants are healthy to study abroad
- 5 passport-sized photograph
- Copy of valid passport (minimum 18 months since the beginning of the program)
