

*Admission to Project Success Summer Program
Waiting List Procedures*

The Project Success Summer Transition program is limited to 40 students each summer. Students will be selected for the summer transition program based on the following procedure:

1. Applications will be evaluated in the order they are received according to the date that the completed application is received at the Project Success office. The completed application must include:
 - a. Completed Project Success Application form with student letter
 - b. Copy of applicant's high school transcript (with senior year schedule for students still in high school)
 - c. ACT test results
 - d. Current (completed within the last two years) disability documentation (if current documentation is not immediately available, applicants can send items a, b, and c above and begin the application process. Applicants must then send documentation when it becomes available to complete their file.)
2. The application materials will be evaluated to determine if the student has a documented *language-based* disability in the areas of reading and written language. (ADD or ADHD alone is not an appropriate fit for our program)
3. If the applicant has a language-based disability, his or her high school transcript and ACT information will be forwarded to the UW Oshkosh Admissions office to determine if the student is eligible for admission to UW Oshkosh under Project Success admission requirements (the Project Success web site has a current listing of eligibility requirements.)
4. When it is determined that the applicant has a language-based disability and has the necessary high school credits to be admissible to UW Oshkosh, the applicant will be contacted to schedule an appointment for testing and interview at the Project Success office (generally during a student's senior year in high school.)
5. Upon completion of testing, the applicant will be informed if he or she is an appropriate candidate for Project Success and his or her name will be placed on the summer transition program student list and the student will be invited to campus for testing and interview with the Project Success program director or associate director.
6. When a summer transition program student list reaches 40, a waiting list will be established of persons qualified for the summer transition program. The order of the list will be based on the order that the person completed *testing and interview* for the summer program.

- a. By March 1 of each year, the first 40 applicants on the summer transition program list for the following summer will be sent a mailing with registration information on the summer transition program for their specified year. Qualified applicants will have until March 31 of the year before the summer program to register for the summer program. Registering for the summer program, which is done by completing returning all registration forms and returning them to the Project Success office by March 31.
7. On April 1, if all 40 summer transition program openings are not filled, applicants on the waiting list beginning with the first applicant and continuing to the number of openings remaining for the summer program, will be sent a mailing with registration information for the summer 2004 transition program. Applicants will have until April 30, to return their completed applications (see #7 above for listing of necessary items).
8. If openings exist on May 1 applicants on the waiting list beginning with the first applicant and continuing to the number of openings remaining for the summer transition program, will be sent a mailing with registration information for the summer transition program. Applicants will have until May 31 to return their completed applications (see #7 above for listing of necessary items).
