3. Meetings

The committee met a total of 5 times in the 2010-11 academic year for approximately an hour to an hour and a half each time. The meeting dates were: October 21, November 18, December 16, January 20, and May 19.



4. Business

The following is a list of items addressed by the Health and Safety Committee in 2010-11.

- a. Discussion items:
 - i. Campus lighting.
 - ii. Campus smoking near buildings.
 - iii. Scooters, mopeds, and bicycles on campus in pedestrian areas.
 - iv. Drinking water in Dempsey seems to be discolored.
 - v. Adam Bellcorelli indicated snowfall is causing problems at entrances to some buildings for students and staff with disabilities (especially individuals in wheelchairs).
- b. Training topics:
 - i. The committee watched a video and discussed the role of the Safety Committee.
 - ii. D2L training classes were established for OSHA training by the Office of Risk Management.
 - iii. Chief of Police, Joe LeMire reported that NFPA has an on-line training available for crowd control. University Police will be implementing the training.
- c. Action items:
 - i. University Police was advised to increase enforcement of keeping scooters off sidewalks. Parking and University Police staff met to further review potential solutions for scooter, moped, and bike safety issues. Future plans will include discussion with Facilities and Michael Lizotte regarding long-range plans for bike, pedestrian, moped, and scooter safety on campus (parking areas, enforcement, education, etc.).
 - ii. Health and Safety Committee advised Facilities staff to test the drinking water in Dempsey Hall. Tests were completed, and the system was flushed. The quality of drinking water will continue to be monitored.
 - iii. Adam Bellcorelli volunteered to lead an effort to develop a plan to better deal with the snow removal issue. Dawn Dettlaff, Chuck Hermes, Joe LeMire, Mark Strufert and Tom Witte are the staff whom are working with Adam to resolve the snow removal at entrances that will allow better access for those with disabilities.
