Webster Stanley is one of the more ethnically and economically diverse school populations in the area, so this is a wonderful opportunity for all Education or Human Service majors. Here are some of the details at a glance:

- There are approximately 30 students who will be required to attend the program, based on their low grades in certain core subjects, and their teachers' recommendations.
- The program will also be open to "Drop In" students who would like to stop in for help on any given day.
- University Students will be offering study help in the core subject areas: Math, Literacy, Science, and Social Studies (6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, and 8<sup>th</sup> grades), and obviously some fun and socialization along the way (although homework comes FIRST)
- The program will start as soon as possible, running **Monday through Friday, from 3-4:30 p.m.**
- Volunteers are required to log a **minimum of 10 hours** for their obligation to me, although your Major most likely requires more than that (check with your apartment administrator to be sure). And even though I cannot expect my volunteers to serve more than 10 hours, I sincerely hope and encourage everyone to serve more than that! The benefit to the kids will be immeasurable.
