Catching the bus

Go to the street on which your bus operates a few minutes ahead of the scheduled arrival time. Check the map for direction of travel and wait on the corner.

You do not have to wait at a bus stop. When you see the bus coming, step up to the curb, either at the corner or a bus stop, and hail the bus by waving your hand. Board the bus, show your TitanCard or pay your fare and take a seat.

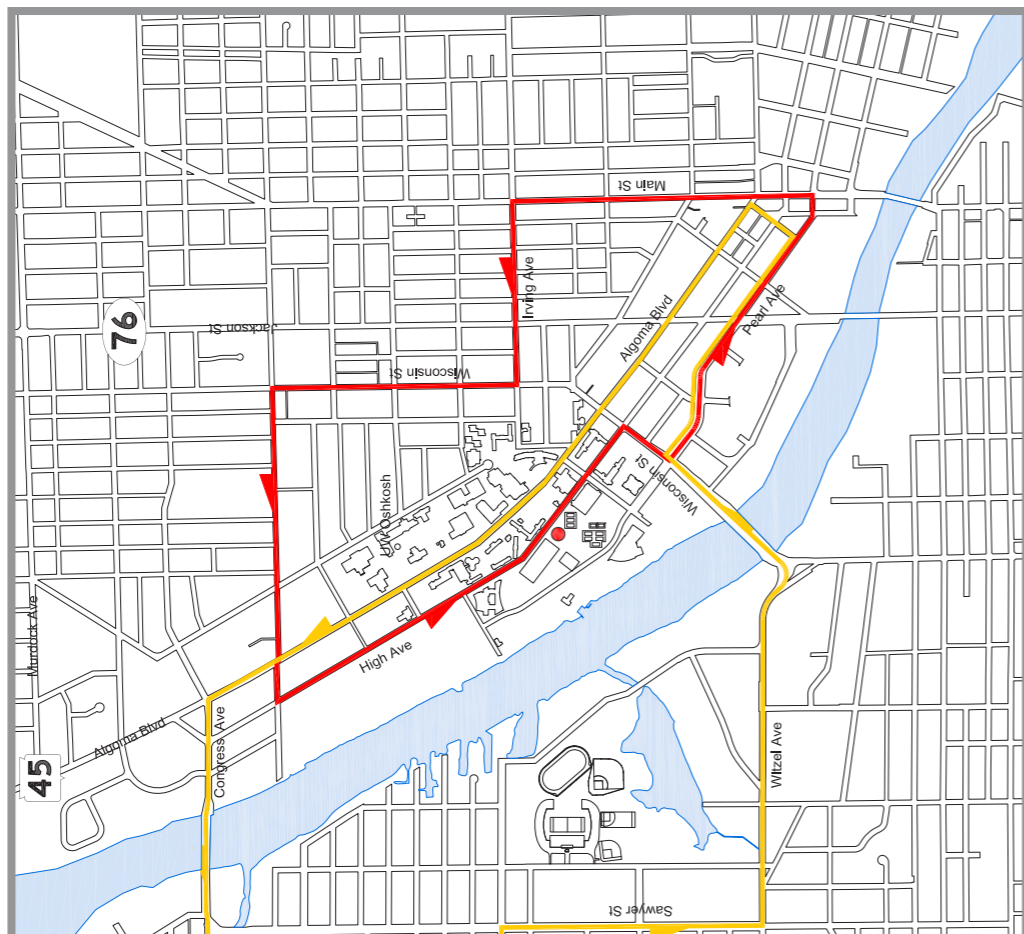
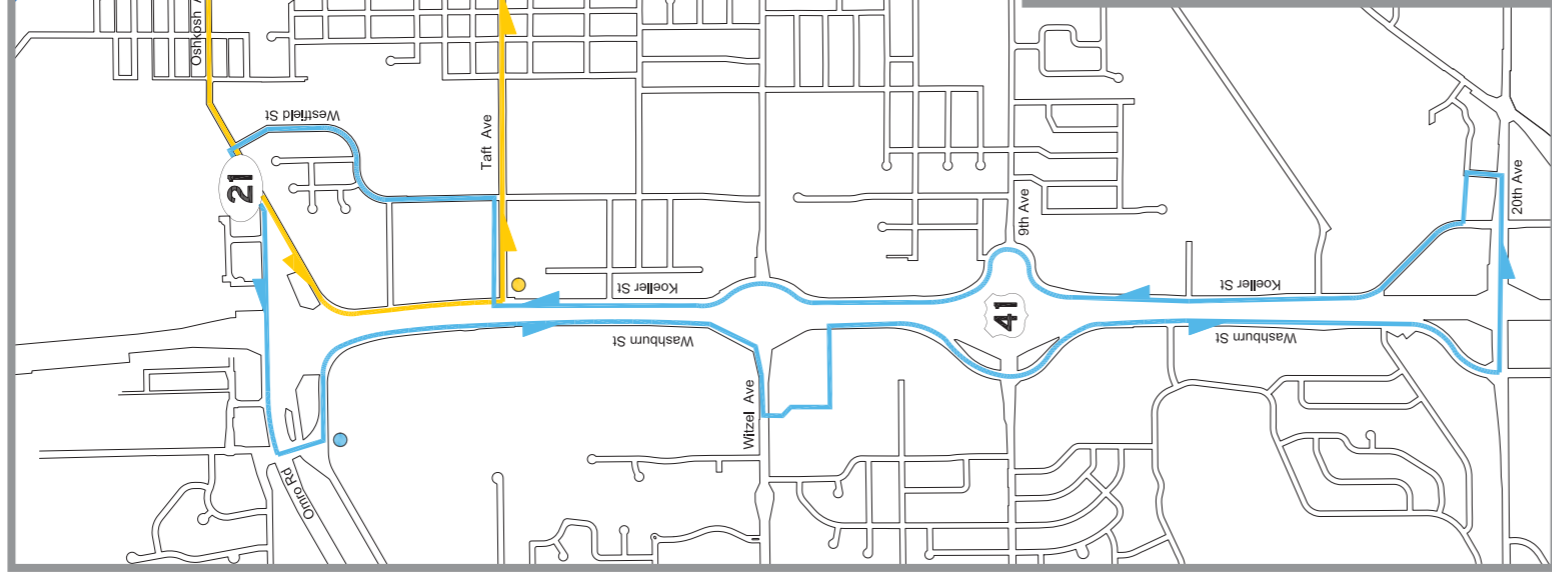

BUS ROUTES AND SCHEDULES



Titan Transit buses run during

UW Oshkosh's regular 14-week semesters. This includes from after Labor Day to approximately mid-December and from approximately February to mid-May, excluding major holidays and spring break (mid-March).

Titan Transit buses stop at City of Oshkosh bus stops along the routes if someone is waiting. Otherwise, you can hail the Titan Transit bus at any corner by waving your hand to get the driver's attention.
