### **Definition of Sustainability Research:**

The Campus Sustainability Plan (2008) set a long term vision for research: Scholarly activities by faculty, staff and students generate and test ideas for creating a sustainable future.

The Campus Sustainability Council in 2012 approved a definition of Sustainability Research as:

*Sustainability Research contributes to understanding the environmental, social, and/or economic status and/or needs of current and future generations. These human needs should be interpreted broadly to recognize the challenges of balancing ecological integrity and quality of life.*

**Method:** The inventory was based on a review of departmental and faculty websites. Stated research interests, project descriptions, and publication lists were used to determine which faculty fit the definition provided above.
