

Program Administration

The UWS Women and Science program is facilitated by a half-time program director and program assistant. It is also guided by an Advisory Board consisting of two representatives from each UW Institution, a representative of the UWS Women's Studies Consortium, two representatives from business and industry, and two student representatives.

The Women and Science Program maintains close ties with the University of Wisconsin System Women's Studies Consortium, which serves as the formal organization of the fourteen campus-based Women's Studies Programs and UW-Extension. The Consortium has identified curricular reform as one of its primary goals and, because of the challenges presented by the sciences, has designated Women and Science as a focus area within that goal. UW System President Katherine Lyall commissioned a systemwide study on the Status of Women in 1998. The panel's results and final report can be found [here](#).

The UWS Women's Studies Consortium's Women's Studies Librarian's Office has a variety of publications and bibliographies, such as *The History of Women and Science, Health, and Technology: A Bibliographic Guide to the Professions and the Disciplines and Information Technology and Women's Lives*. In addition, the Librarian's Office provides curriculum support, interinstitutional cooperation, information-sharing, and advocacy related to the field of women's studies and to gender-focused scholarship in the traditional disciplines.
