# Free Tax Preparation Assistance\*

## What is Volunteer Income Tax Assistance Program (VITA)?

The VITA Program offers **free tax help to low- to moderate-income\*** (generally, \$40,000 and below) people who cannot prepare their own tax returns. Certified volunteers sponsored by various organizations receive training to help prepare basic tax returns in communities across the country. ~Source: IRS.gov

## What income tax forms will a VITA/TCE site prepare?

A VITA site will prepare the following:  
1040EZ; 1040A with Schedules 1, 2, 3, and EIC; 1040 with Schedules A, B, EIC, and R; Form 1040V (Payment Voucher); Form 1040ES (Individual Estimated Tax Payment); Form 2441 (Child and Dependent Care Credit); Form 8863 (Educational Credits); Form 8812 (Additional Child Tax Credit)

**Many will qualify for free online filing!**

## Items you need to bring with to have your tax returns prepared:

- **Proof of identification**
- Social Security Cards for you, your spouse and dependents and/or a Social Security Number verification letter issued by the Social Security Administration
- **Birth dates for you, your spouse and dependents on the tax return**
- Current year's tax package if you received one
- Wage and earning statement(s) Form W-2, W-2G, 1099-R, from all employers
- Interest and dividend statements from banks (Forms 1099)
- A copy of last year's Federal and State returns *if available*
- Bank Routing Numbers and Account Numbers for Direct Deposit
- **Total paid for day care provider and the day care provider's tax identifying number** (the provider's Social Security Number or the provider's business Employer Identification Number)
- To file taxes electronically on a married filing joint tax return, both spouses must be present to sign the required forms.
