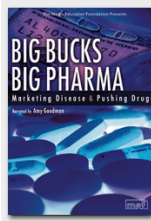


Spin the Bottle: Sex, Lies & Alcohol

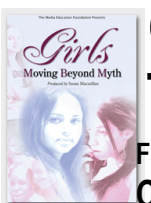
Big Bucks, Big Pharma: Marketing Disease & Pushing Drugs
