

## FM Radio Station

A low-power FM, educational radio station will begin broadcasting sometime during the 1965-66 school year. The station will be staffed and operated by students under faculty supervision. All students of the university are eligible to work on the staff of the station. Auditions will be required of all on-the-air personnel.

All programming and announcements must meet the programming schedule and policies of the station and be in accordance with the rules and regulations of the F. C. C. Programming and announcements must be approved by the station manager and/or the faculty advisor.

### Applicant's Purpose + Objective in Establishing The Proposed Station

The purpose and objective in establishing the proposed station is threefold:

1. Provide listeners in the city of Oshkosh and its vicinity <sup>including ~~most of~~ ~~the~~ ~~area~~ ~~of~~ ~~F.D.C.~~</sup> with a schedule of educational, informational, and entertainment programming supplementary to the established broadcasting services. ~~Program~~

3. Provide Wisconsin State University - Oshkosh with an effective instrument of public information in the area from which it draws most of <sup>its</sup> students, acquainting the public with the program and activities of the university.
