



**Program-to-Program Articulation Agreement
November 17, 2011**

1. **Degree Granting Institution:** University of Wisconsin Oshkosh
Degree: Bachelor of Science – Human Services Leadership (BS-HSL)
2. **Transfer Institution:** Lac Courte Oreilles Ojibwe Community College (LCO), Hayward, WI
Degree: Associate of Arts in Human Services
3. **Effective date:** Fall Semester 2012
4. **Review date:** This agreement will be reviewed in Fall 2017 or sooner should affected requirements change at either program.
5. **Explanation and rationale** – this agreement represents an educational partnership between UW Oshkosh and Lac Courte Oreilles Ojibwe Community College which has the purpose of expanding baccalaureate educational opportunities in Human Services for graduates of LCO.
6. **Credits from LCO to transfer to UW Oshkosh:** Under this agreement students will be awarded 36 credits as specified in the Oshkosh transfer system (OTIS - <http://www.uwosh.edu/admissions/otis>); see attachment. An additional 12 credits will be provided for the following courses, which will satisfy UWO BS-HSL program requirements:

Lastly, students will be awarded up 15 credits in block, based only upon their human services content-related (i.e. non-general education) course work, which will be applied toward the 120 total needed to graduate. The total number of transfer credits may not exceed the total number required for the Associates degree. Also, this agreement abides by UW System policy to transfer a maximum of 72 credits earned at applicable two-year institutions to University of Wisconsin baccalaureate degree programs.

7. Conditions:

- The terms of this agreement apply only to students accepted into the Bachelor of Science in Human Services Leadership degree program at UW Oshkosh. Students admitted to UW Oshkosh under the terms of this agreement who subsequently elect to pursue a degree other than the BS-HSL may encounter additional program requirements.
- Students from the above-mentioned LCO program must have successfully completed their Associate degree in Human Services (fulfilling all course work stipulated therein) with a graduating grade point average of 2.5 or higher in order to be eligible for inclusion under this agreement. Students must have graduated in 1990 or later. These terms do not apply to students who have completed only a portion of the required course work for the Associate degree.
