



Program-to-Program Articulation Agreement
January 1, 2018

1. **Degree Granting Institution:** University of Wisconsin Oshkosh online Bachelor of Liberal Studies Program (BLS)
2. **Transfer Institution:** Kishwaukee College (Malta, IL) Associate of Arts Degree; Associate of Science Degree
3. **Effective date:** Fall Semester 2018
4. **Review date:** This agreement will be reviewed in Fall 2023 or sooner should affected requirements change at either program.
5. **Explanation and rationale:** This agreement is being established in order to expand educational opportunities for graduates of Kishwaukee College, Malta, and to strengthen the educational partnership between UW Oshkosh and the Illinois Community College System.
6. **Kishwaukee College courses and UW Oshkosh equivalents:** General education credits earned at Kishwaukee College will be recognized as having met UW Oshkosh general education requirements as specified in attachment #1.
7. **Credits from Kishwaukee College to transfer to UW Oshkosh:** see attachment #2.
8. **Conditions:**
 - The terms of this agreement apply only to students accepted into the Bachelor of Liberal Studies degree program at UW Oshkosh. Students admitted to UW Oshkosh under the terms of this agreement who subsequently elect to pursue a degree other than the BLS may encounter additional program requirements.
 - Students from the above-mentioned Kishwaukee College programs must have successfully completed their Associate of Arts or Science degree (fulfilling all course work stipulated therein) with a graduating grade point average of 2.5 or higher in order to

be eligible for inclusion under this agreement. These terms do not apply to students who have completed only a portion of the required course work for this Associate degree.

- Students successfully completing the above-mentioned Kishwaukee College program will have satisfied the university-wide general education requirements at UW Oshkosh except for Ethnic Studies, Global Citizenship, and upper division courses specifically required for this major.




