#### **Re-enrollment Campaigns**

During these uncertain times, many students have delayed registering for spring classes. As retention has become more important than ever before, many faculty and staff have been asked or volunteered to conduct re-enrollment campaigns. #### **Virtual Registration Support**

Students that are new to UW Oshkosh this fall may not have learned how to enroll in classes yet, especially freshmen. Since Titan Takeoff was virtual this summer, advisors enrolled their classes while screen sharing with them. Therefore, a new [Registration Toolkit](#) has been created to take them through the steps for Pre-registration, Registration, and Post Registration. Please refer students to this site.

## **TIS (Transfer Information System) Replaced with Transferology, TES**

UW System coordinated the launch of Transferology and TES, online credit transfer tools, to make transfer easier and more efficient in Wisconsin by replacing the TIS transfer credit wizard.

### **Transferology—Student Website**

Transferology is a free online database of transfer equivalencies. Prospective students can use the pathway, “Will My Courses Transfer?”, to discover how their credits transfer to UW Oshkosh. Current UWO students can use the pathway, “Find a Replacement Course”, to search for courses to complete at another school that can be transferred back to UWO. Students can add coursework, exams and/or military learning experiences to see how those credits match at UW Oshkosh.
