Open Advising Hours (First week of the semester)

At the start of each term the UARC operates using an "Open Advising" model. Students are seen on a first come first served basis and no appointments are scheduled. This allows us to address the large volume of advising concerns that come up at the beginning of the semester. Open Advising can be done In-person (come to UARC) or virtually (call UARC at 920-424-1268) based on student preference.
