Three Things Before Starting

1. You only need to apply for CAPP ONCE. One application lasts until your high school graduation.

NOTE: a general application to UW-O is not the same. A specific CAPP app is needed. Please see alternate instructions or contact CAPP with questions.

2. The application takes about 15 to 20 minutes to complete. If you find it taking much longer than that, please reach out!

We can figure out almost every issue within a couple minutes.

3. All submitted information should be that of the student.

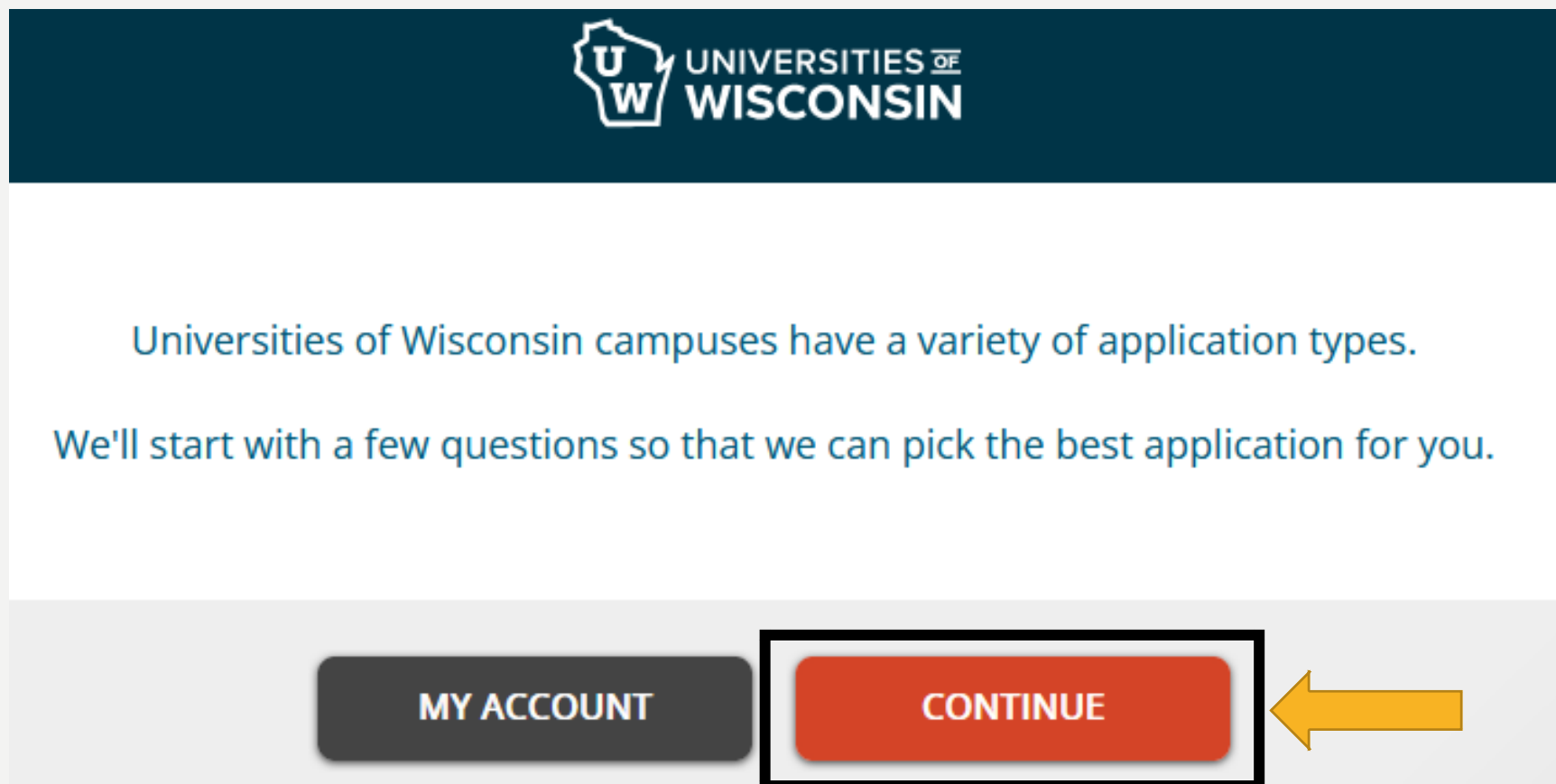

6 THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW (PART 1)

- 1) This is only the first step of getting CAPP credit.
 - The application serves a general purpose to create your student record in our system.
 - The second step, Registration, commits you to your specific classes, but doesn't open until a few weeks before the class starts.

- 2) We have a no-penalty drop deadline.
 - No-penalty means you can drop your CAPP class for any reason and get your money back.
 - The drop deadline is a few weeks after the registration deadline for the same term.
 - You CANNOT drop after the drop deadline unless you have a health or family emergency.

- 3) CAPP Tuition is \$110 per credit
 - If you are on Free or Reduced Lunch, your tuition is reduced to \$55 per credit

6 THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW (PART 2)

- 4) Tell your parent or guardian that you're taking CAPP!
 - Make sure they are aware of your CAPP class and the tuition, so the payment is not a surprise!

- 5) If you applied by July 31, then you will receive information on the registration steps by email in early August.
 - If you start CAPP in Spring, apply by December 20 to get information emailed in early January
 - The email will go to the email address you gave us at the start of the application. Add CAPP (capp@uwosh.edu) as a contact or safe sender so our email doesn't end up in spam!

- 6) If you applied AFTER July 31 (or, for Spring, December 20), you won't receive registration instructions until at least a week after you apply.
 - **If you haven't received instructions by email within two weeks after applying (if after the above date), contact the CAPP Office, capp@uwosh.edu.**
