

LETTER OF PROGRAM MEMORANDUM FOR PE 624
UNIVERSITY OF WISCONSIN OSHKOSH
DEPARTMENT OF Human Kinetics and Health Education

This memorandum details the agreement between the University of Wisconsin Oshkosh Department of Human Kinetics and Health Education and sites where candidates are enrolled in the class PE 624.

The Department of Human Kinetics and Health Education will expect the following of the teacher candidate while at the site:

- To demonstrate knowledge and understanding of the goals, objectives, and purposes of adventure education in both the preK-12 as well as the commercial setting.
- To work independently to develop an adventure-based program to teach to all age levels.
- To acquire a working knowledge of the Association for Challenge Course Technology standards (depending on the placement).
- To demonstrate knowledge, understanding of, and competence in the professional responsibilities of an intern in the outdoor education/recreation setting.
- To evaluate adventure education as well as outdoor education curriculums in coordination with the cooperating supervisor and/or cooperating teacher.

The site will provide the following:

- An opportunity to work and teach in an outdoor adventure education-based placement.
- Guidance safety and industrial best practices.
- Corrective and positive feedback to allow the student to improve.
