

LETTER OF PROGRAM MEMORANDUM FOR PE 208Q3
UNIVERSITY OF WISCONSIN OSHKOSH
DEPARTMENT OF Human Kinetics and Health Education

This memorandum details the agreement between the University of Wisconsin Oshkosh Department of Human Kinetics and Health Education and sites where candidates are enrolled in the class PE 208Q3.

The Department of Human Kinetics and Health Education will expect the following of the teacher candidate while at the site:

- Basic understanding of how outdoor adventure education (OAE) can be used within the physical education curriculum and beyond.
- An understanding of the adventure process and its purpose in school and community curricula.
- An understanding risk management principles and strategies.
- How to use rock climbing and ropes course equipment.
- Assistance with teaching hard skills such as knot tying, belaying, climbing, and soft skills such as debriefing and processing within adventure education.
- A demonstration of pedagogical concepts in OAE.
- A demonstration of competence in multiple OAE activities.

The site will provide the following:

- An opportunity to teach students outdoor adventure education activities in the physical education or community setting.
- An opportunity to be an assistant facilitator including some teaching and demonstration of skills.
