

UNIVERSITY OF **WISCONSIN-OSHKOSH**

Founded in 1871, the Oshkosh State Normal School became Wisconsin's foremost teacher-training institution. In later years, as the focus and curriculum expanded, the institution underwent several name changes. A graduate school was added in 1963. In its centennial year of 1971, President Roger Earl Guiles guided UW–Oshkosh's merger into the Wisconsin system.

UW–Oshkosh prepares students for fulfilling lives and challenging careers with programs spanning a wide array of disciplines.

Chancellor Manohar Singh leads this vibrant educational institution under a strategic plan with a focus on student success. The picturesque and environmentally conscious campuses are home to three colleges—Business, Arts and Communication; Nursing, Health Professions and STEM; and Public Affairs and Education. UW–Oshkosh's focus on teaching continues to shine in its distinction of having won 11 UW System Regents Teaching Awards of Excellence.

Universities of Wisconsin is governed by the Board of Regents, an 18-member board of which 16 are appointed by the governor. The board, in turn, appoints the system president and the chancellors of the 13 universities. The current system president is Jay O. Rothman.

Ceremonial TRADITIONS

Academic Procession

This commencement ceremony marks a special occasion for students completing degree programs offered by UW–Oshkosh. The Chancellor grants degrees by virtue of the powers vested by Universities of Wisconsin Board of Regents. In addition, academic degrees may only be granted upon the recommendation of the University's faculty.

The academic procession is a featured part of the commencement program—a symbolic declaration that all members of the academic community are bound by common purpose and shared commitment to the ideals of higher education, including the search for meaning, truth and understanding.

Academic Attire

Academic regalia connects today's graduates to centuries of university tradition. The gowns, caps and hoods worn in the ceremony reflect both degree level and field of study.

- **Caps:** The familiar square cap or mortarboard replaces the rounded cap once worn by scholars in medieval Europe.
- **Gowns:**
 - Bachelor's gowns feature long, pointed sleeves and are worn closed.
 - Master's gowns have oblong sleeves open at the wrist.
 - Doctoral gowns include velvet trim on the front and sleeves and may be worn open or closed.
- **Tassels:** The color of each tassel represents the graduate's field of study.

Kazeem Akinyele is an associate professor of accounting in the UW-Oshkosh School of Business. He teaches courses in managerial accounting, cost management and advanced cost management and serves as the accounting discipline coordinator and faculty advisor for accounting majors. He previously chaired the accounting department.

Akinyele's research focuses on judgment and decision-making in managerial accounting and has appeared in academic journals including *Behavioral Research in Accounting, Accounting & Finance, Accounting and the Public Interest, Accounting Forum* and *Issues in Accounting Education*.

He earned his doctorate from the University of Central Florida, an MBA from Rollins College in Winter Park, Florida and a bachelor's degree in statistics from Obafemi Awolowo University in Ile-Ife, Nigeria. His work has been recognized through honors including the 2025 UW-Oshkosh Edward M. 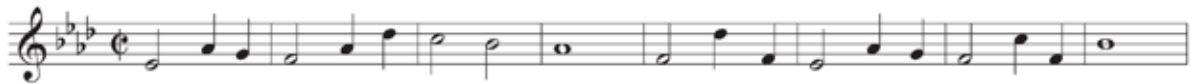
