The internship emphasizes real-world applications, policy analysis, community engagement, and interagency collaboration.**

Duration: 7 weeks (Spring Interim & Summer Term)/ 3 credits.

#### **Wisconsin Division of Community Corrections (DCC) - Winnebago Region**
