Term – This academic year through May 2020

Meeting frequency – First Thursday of each month (starting November 7), through May 2020, no meeting January 2020. Other meetings as determined if participating on a standing sub-committee. Meetings on campus.

Length of meetings – 1 ½ hours

Description

The Graduate Council is responsible for formulating the policies concerning the graduate programs of the University of Wisconsin Oshkosh. It serves as an advisory body to the Provost and Vice Chancellor of Academic Affairs and to the Dean of Graduate Studies concerning the implementation of these policies. The Graduate Council has the function and power to...

- A. Establish goals, directions, and standards at the University of Wisconsin Oshkosh to promote quality and consistency in standards in graduate education.
- B. Provide oversight in developing, executing, or implementing the strategic plan for graduate studies and initiatives, action steps, or activities necessary to achieve the goals of the strategic plan.
- C. Advise the Provost and Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs and the Dean of Graduate Studies on matters related to planning and coordinating graduate education.
- D. Suggests that the Provost and Vice Chancellor for Academic Affairs and the Dean of Graduate Studies support specific actions to be undertaken on matters of concern to the Graduate Council.

SEGREGATED FEES COMMITTEE

Term – This academic year through May 2020

Meeting frequency - One meeting later this fall, a Saturday budgets review session in mid- to late-February (morning to mid-afternoon), and one wrap-up meeting later in the spring semester. Meetings on campus.

Length of meetings – Fall: 1-2 hours; February: approx. 9a to 2 or 3p; April/May: 1-2 hours

Description

The Segregated Fee Committee is responsible for recommending the maximum level of assessment of segregated university fees. The committee consists of eight students — seven voting and one non-voting — appointed by the Oshkosh Student Association (OSA), two faculty appointed by the Faculty Senate, two academic staff appointed by the Senate of Academic Staff, two University Staff appointed by the University Staff Senate, and one committee adviser appointed by the Vice Chancellor for Student Affairs (non-voting).
