



2024 BECKMAN SCHOLARS PROGRAM OVERVIEW AND APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Description of the Beckman Scholars Program:

Funded by the Arnold and Mabel Beckman Foundation, the <u>Beckman Scholars Program</u> (BSP) is a 15-month mentored research experience for exceptional undergraduate students in chemistry, biological sciences, or interdisciplinary combinations thereof. The UW Oshkosh Beckman Scholars Program will accept six Beckman Scholars over the next three years, taking in two new scholars annually (2024, 2025, 2026). Beginning this summer, selected Beckman Scholars will conduct research alongside a <u>named Beckman Mentor</u> and receive a stipend of \$18,200 over the course of the Program.

Prior to submitting Beckman Application:

- □ Schedule at least one appointment with <u>Cordelia Bowlus</u>, the Beckman Scholars Program Manager.
- ☐ Meet with a <u>prospective Beckman Mentor</u> who is willing to support your application. Discuss the project you wish to participate in.
- □ Identify at least one faculty member willing and able to write a recommendation on your behalf.
- □ Complete the Beckman application (this document) and write a personal statement (500-750 words), articulating your motivation for working with said mentor, personality characteristics you possess that make you suited to become a Beckman Scholar, course work and experiences that have prepared you to conduct research, and how being a Beckman Scholar will advance your short and long-term goals.
