Decision Title:	Admissions Policy for Transit Students

Recommended Decision

Transit students* follow the same UWO admission policy for USP requirements as transfer students (see <https://uwosh.edu/admissions/how-to-apply/transfer/>) until uniform associate degree standards for the restructured university are in place. Guidelines for USP requirements for transit students will be reevaluated when associate degree standards for the restructured university are determined.

*Those who start at Fox Valley or Fond du Lac campuses and then transit within UW Oshkosh for further study.

Background

UW Oshkosh admission policies outline USP requirements for transfer students on the basis of the number of incoming credits. For example, a student bringing in between 15 and 59 credits is not required to complete the QUEST sequence. The guidelines acknowledge that the experiences of transfer students “are a bit different.” This difference may continue to describe the experiences of FOX/FDL students until uniform associate degree standards are determined for the restructured institution (OSH + FOX + FDL). Until such time, associate-degree-seeking students at FOX/FDL may or may not have access to USP curriculum as the access campuses will continue to offer curriculum that supports the current UW Colleges associate degree standards. It is not anticipated that uniform associate degree standards will be in effect prior to the fall of 2020. This working group is tasked with evaluating and forming a recommendation on associate degree standards for the restructured institution (OSH + FOX + FDL). This group has previously recommended Fall 2020 as the timeline for implementing uniform standards.
