Decision Title:	Parking at UW Oshkosh

Recommended Decision

With the amount of restructuring committee work that the faculty and staff are engaged in, we propose to allow a transitional year with regards to paid parking for the UW-Fox Valley and UW-Fond du Lac faculty and staff working to improve the services our campuses will provide.

Background

This "parking transition year" will allow for face-to-face meetings where UWO and UW-Fox Valley and UW-Fond du Lac can re-imagine the ways we provide services. It will also give departments and employees time to understand the budget implications working between campuses may have. Permits will be valid in any employee lot or in the blue and yellow parking lots on our map. (See attached parking map.)

Permits will be provided for the 2018-2019 academic year, valid through August 31, 2019. After this transition period, access campus-based employees can contact Parking Services to find the type of permit which will work best for their schedule.

Next Steps

FOX & FDL FACULTY/STAFF ONLY:
For the 2018-19 year only, we will not charge any parking permit fees to employees of FDL & FOX faculty/staff. We will have six employee permits marked with a "T" for transition team, which can be checked out and returned at each campus. UW-Fox Valley permits will be held by Jenean Hodge, and UW-Fond Du Lac permits will be held by Fran Holzmann. A check-in/out sheet will be maintained at each campus to ensure these permits are not misused or misplaced.
