

<b>Decision Title:</b>	<b>Conduct, Compliance, and Behavioral Health Restructuring</b>

<b>Recommended Decision</b>
UW Oshkosh will assume responsibility for all conduct, compliance requirements, and student behavioral health concerns on September 1, 2018.

<b>Background</b>
The date to assume these responsibilities was originally set for July 1, 2019. Due to a staff reduction in the UW Colleges central conduct and compliance office, the date needed to be reset to September 1, 2018. However, there are several issues that need to be sorted through. The access campuses have privatized housing and contracted counseling. This makes the sharing of information complicated. There are currently no trained conduct hearing board members at the access campuses, necessitating travel for either the student or the board.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Meetings will continue with the housing personnel to properly train all staff on reporting requirements.</li> <li>• Meetings will continue with the Menasha and Fond du Lac Police for reporting and compliance concerns</li> <li>• Work and discussions will continue with “need to know” and appropriate releases regarding behavioral health concerns for the access campus students</li> </ul>
