**Recommended Decision**

Existing staff absorbed the duties to support the two access campuses, but there are fixed costs in need of on-going funding. One-time start-up costs of \$7,000 not included in total request for new Emergency Procedures Guides (\$1,000), AED Replacements (\$5,000) and First Aid Kits (\$1,000).

**Background**

Risk Management & Safety transitioned early and has been incurring costs from the access campuses (and will continue to do so) in our consolidated operational model.

\$8,400 from “Crosswalk Funding”
